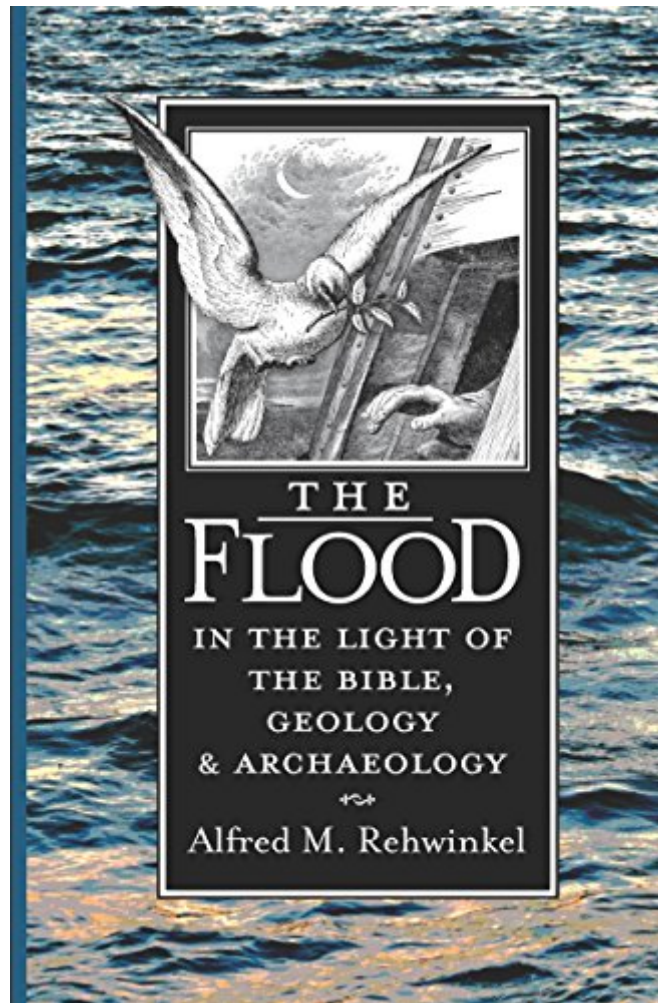


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The Flood: (ebook Edition) (Gr 9-10 1951 1957)
