I love that it highlights some of our favorite Louisiana foods, but it's missing something. The first few pages are basically "Today is Monday in Louisiana. Monday red beans." The remaining pages continue with that same formula. The illustrations mirror what you see on the cover. There's no element of surprise, no humor, no rhyme, nothing that made it a frequent repeat read for our family.
