

In this moving memoir, Eric tells the uplifting story of how he is rebuilding his future with faith. Doctors said that he would never again breathe without a ventilator. Five weeks later, he astonished them by drawing breath on his own. A year after the accident, the nation watched as he led his Rutgers teammates onto the field in his wheelchair. Now Eric is on his way to graduating from Rutgers University, has a budding career as a sports broadcaster, and uses his experience to spread a message of faith and

positivity. Believe is a truly inspiring story of finding purpose in pain and facing setbacks with strength.

Eric is an honorary member of the Tampa Bay Buccaneers, and he has received the Jimmy V Perseverance Award during ESPN's annual ESPY awards show. The writing brings a tone of inspiration and excitement despite the constant trauma and suffering this man has been through, this book speaks in ways where no flaws are evident and there is just

gratefulness in every word LeGrand speaks, how could you not adore such a human!?
