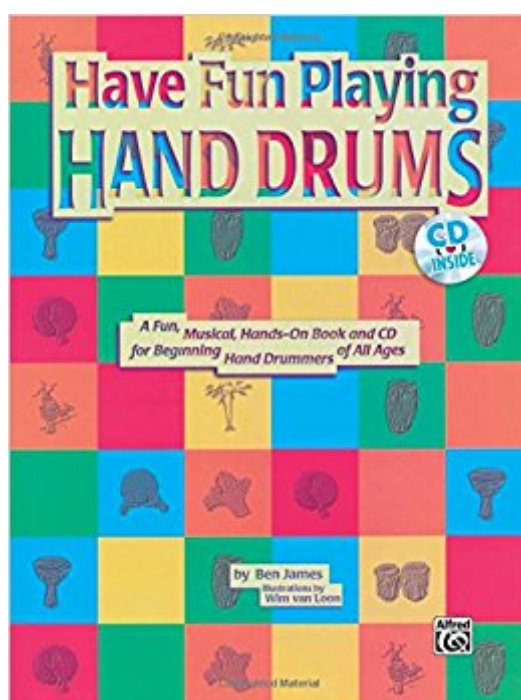

There are general hand drumming tips, playing the natural tone, playing the bass tone, the upbeats, group drumming games, playing the slap tone, rhythm evolution, group drumming rhythms, playing the muff tone, traditional rhythms and play along drum jams.
