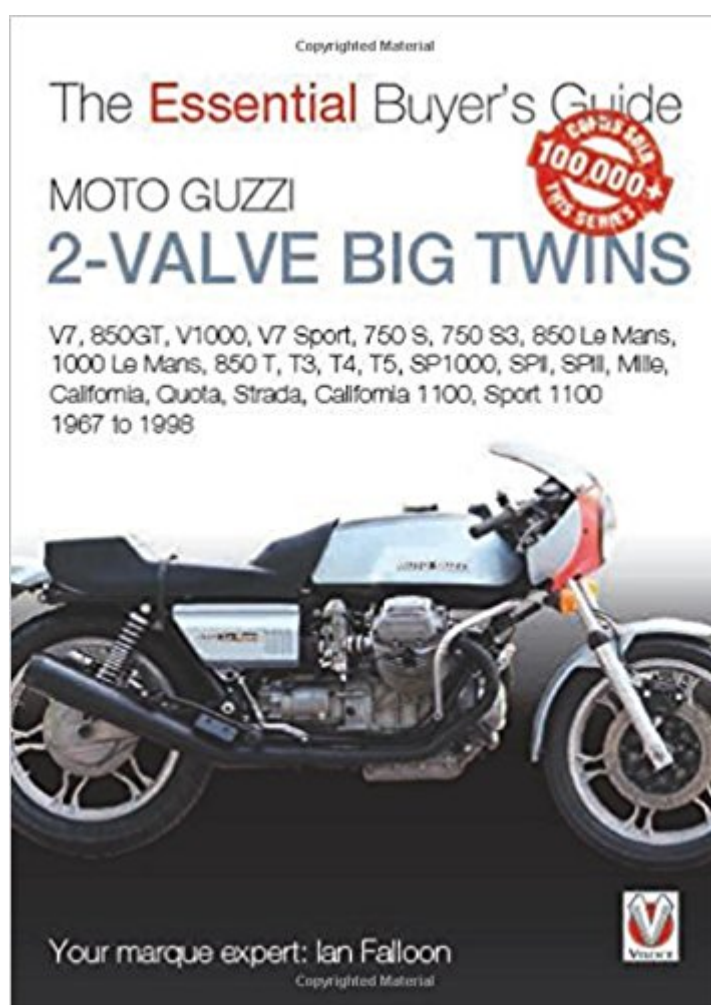

This steaming pile (small pile) of dog waste is not even a book. It is a tiny, 5 x 7 inch, 64-page pamphlet, with microscopic print and postage-stamp sized pictures. It has a bunch of utterly pathetic advice, useless even for the most casual of enthusiasts. Sage statements include:"New spares are expensive, but there is a wide range of aftermarket alternatives available, as well as a good choice of secondhand spares."Gee whiz! No! Really?"Packed with good advice," the cover blurb enthuses. Here are some examples: "Check for loose tank and side cover badges Check for cracks in fiberglass or plastic body work." Thanks, Ian! Think I should I kick the tyres too?How about this clever bit: "The condition of the gearshift rubber is good indicator of the amount of use." True, true. And I don't suppose an unworn one could mean the owner replaced it? Maybe I should check the odometer, as well?Evidently, this "book" originally sold for \$25. I paid \$11 plus postage, and was thoroughly robbed. I'm going to keep it, though, as a reminder to look before I leap.
