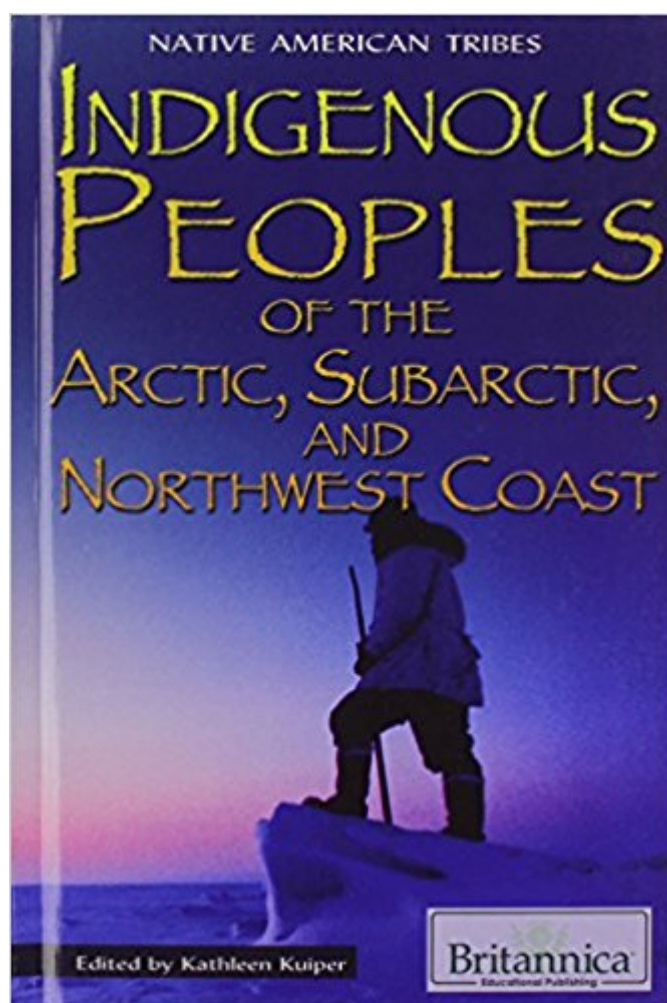




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Indigenous Peoples Of The Arctic, Subarctic, And Northwest Coast (Native American Tribes (Rosen Educational Publishing))
