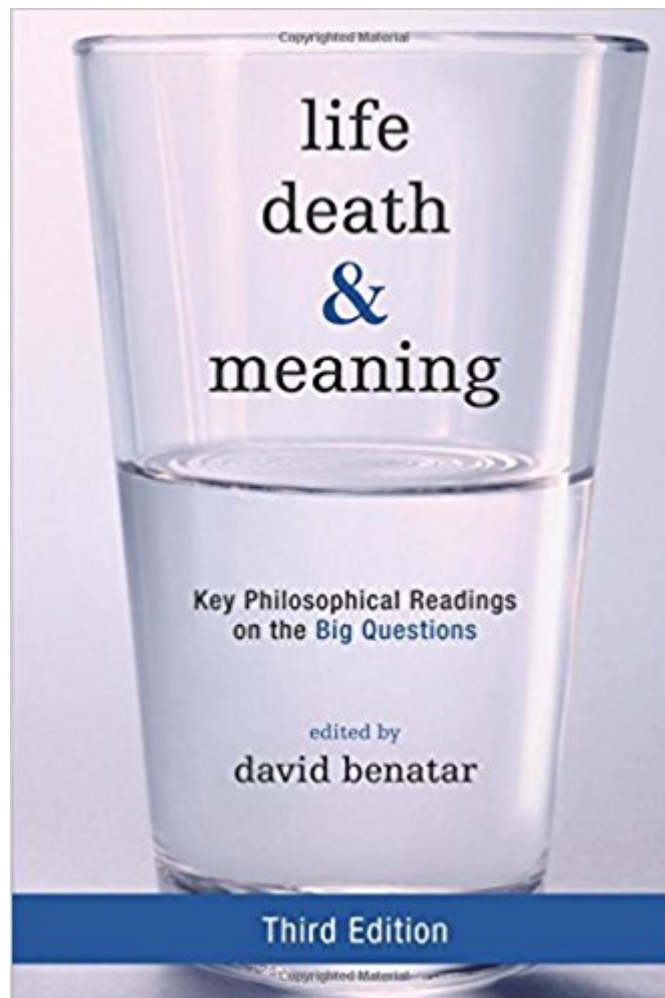




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Life, Death, And Meaning: Key Philosophical Readings On The Big Questions
