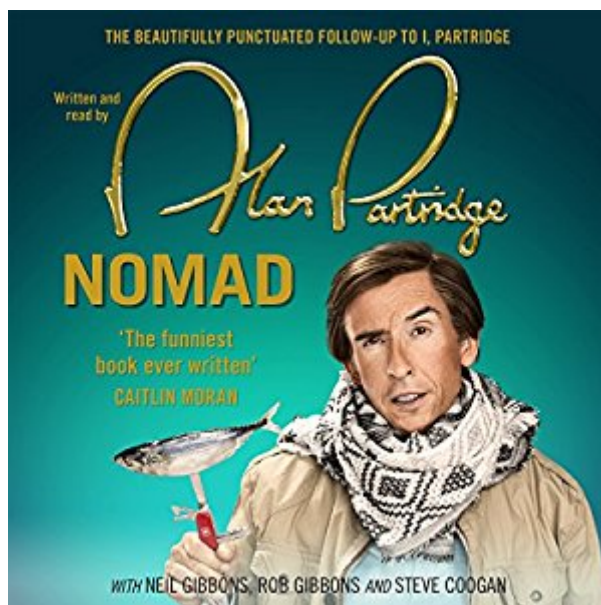

At several points throughout his career, Steve Coogan has said that he's finished with the Alan Partridge character, and several points thereafter, he's resurrected the Alan Partridge character to hilarious result. It seems now, in 2016, that Coogan is resigned to the fact that he can't get away from his most distinctive and best character, and his continued revisitings are only to the fans' benefit. I say let Coogan BE Partridge, from here to eternity. I laughed till I cried at I, Partridge, and I laughed till I cried at Nomad as well. As with all his work, this "memoir" is a frequently uproarious continuation of the Partridge saga, all the better for its ludicrous plot (Alan retraces the path of a job interview his father had at a nuclear plant, walking the route his father drove). Nomad is especially funny for its use of the (incredibly) unreliable narrator, with many more laughs had imagining what really took place versus the way Partridge describes it. Almost every single sentence is funny. For maximum effect I recommend listening to the audio book, where Coogan shines in the role once more. I embarrassed myself frequently giggling out of control in public listening to this, and I highly recommend this experience to you as well. It doesn't get much funnier than Partridge.
