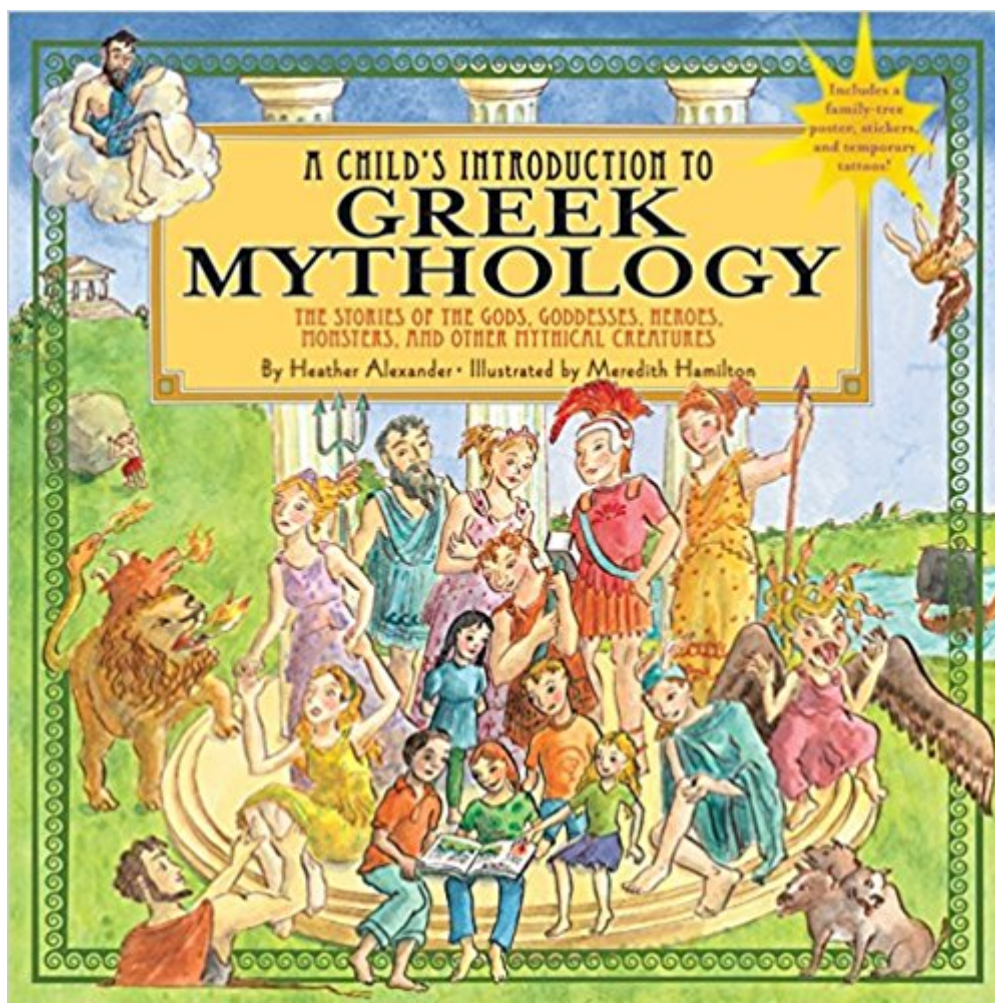

I could rate this two different ways. My very bright, smart and curious 6 YO LOVES the book. That being said... it is clearly not written for her age. A lot of chopped up information with no clear way to read & digest information. Bottom line: It could have been better organized. But all that aside my daughter is happy so maybe that's all that counts.
