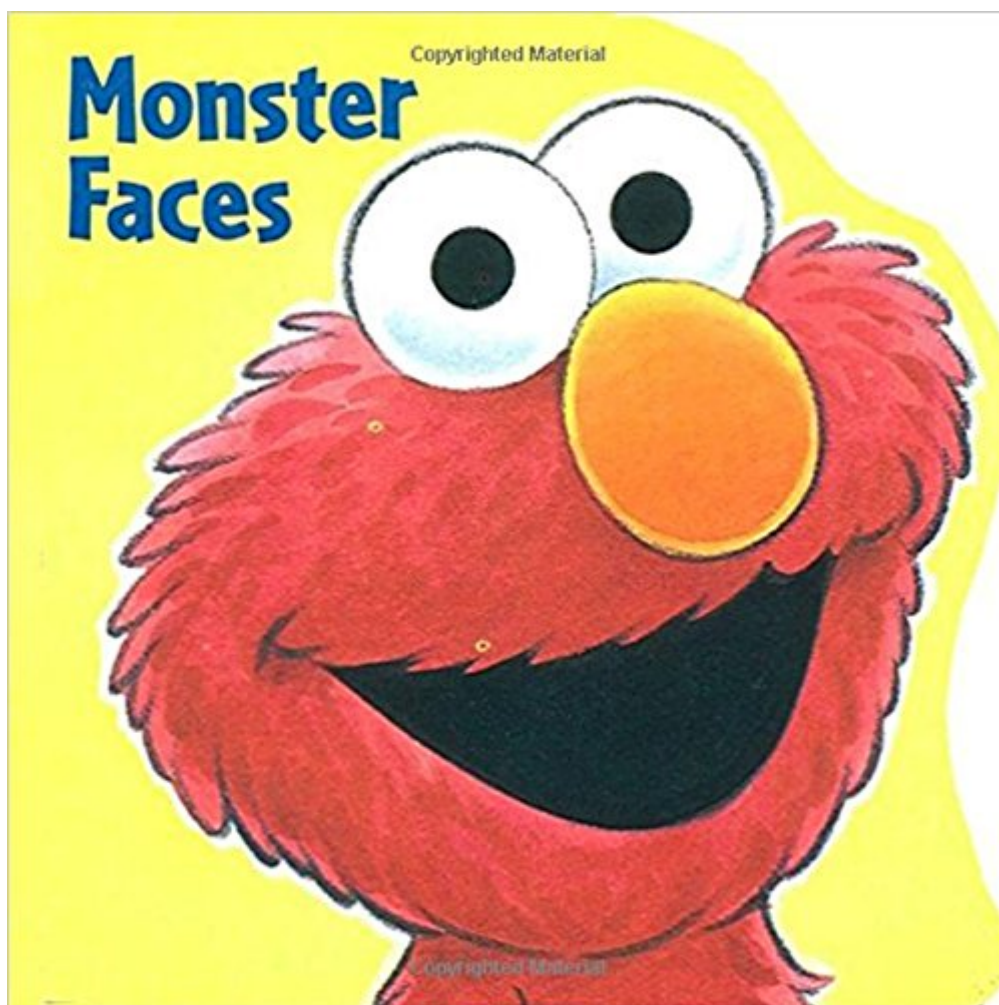

This is adorable! It says the emotion on each page with the monster, like proud or happy. What I love is that it takes it even a step further and implies why each one feels that way. Ex: For scared it has a bee buzzing around the monster's head. It is a very small child-less book. It fits in the palm of

my hand, but my 9 month old can fit it perfectly in his tiny hands. There is no binding, so I'm sure he will rip it apart when he gets older but for right now he hasn't even tried to rip it and instead chews the paper. He loves Sesame Street, so this was perfect!

Our son is a HUGE fan of Elmo - and this is a fantastic book to take on the go as it's not too big and keeps his attention!

It was a lot smaller in size than I expected. It's a mini book. But my son loved it and it held up fairly well with a one year old.

The cute illustrations of favorite Sesame Street characters express a wide range of feelings through facial expressions. Children often need to view some of the less frequent expressions in order to understand and appropriately react to their playmates. This book helps them to interpret these expressions and in many instances, also provides a reason the monster is reacting in this way. This book can help parents teach empathy to their young child and lead to problem solving ways to help and support someone who has these feelings. The size of this book helps it fit into little hands and the many different Sesame Street characters are sure to add much enjoyment. My grandson at 1 1/2 is too young to appreciate this book as he doesn't yet watch television and is only familiar with a few of the characters from other books. He does like Elmo and Oscar best and I'm sure it will soon become a favorite.

Baby's favorite.

This is a cute book - my daughter loves looking at all the different Sesame street guys in it. It was much smaller than expected but I didn't really look up the dimensions when I ordered. It's about 3.5 x 3.5 inches big but that's okay - it will be good to throw in the diaper bag or look at in the car.

This book is small enough to fit in a toddler's hands easily, which should make it easier to follow along with and understand at an early age. Lord knows they love doing things themselves, right? The illustrations are fun and the binding seems sturdy, which is definitely a plus. My only minor complaint is that there's no title or wording on the spine, which means it'll probably just end up sitting in a pile rather than on a shelf for easy reference.

I am a speech therapist and I use this book with babies age 18 mos - 2.5 years. It has been wonderful, much better than I expected when I first saw it. I think the kids like the small size of the book. The faces lend themselves to age-appropriate vocabulary. I was afraid that a book about "emotions" would be too advanced for my lang delayed kiddos but there are a lot of pictures they can relate to even if they don't know the word for the related emotion just yet. They enjoy imitating some of the monsters or making brief comments about what they see, which is what I want them to do. Great book for my purposes!

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
