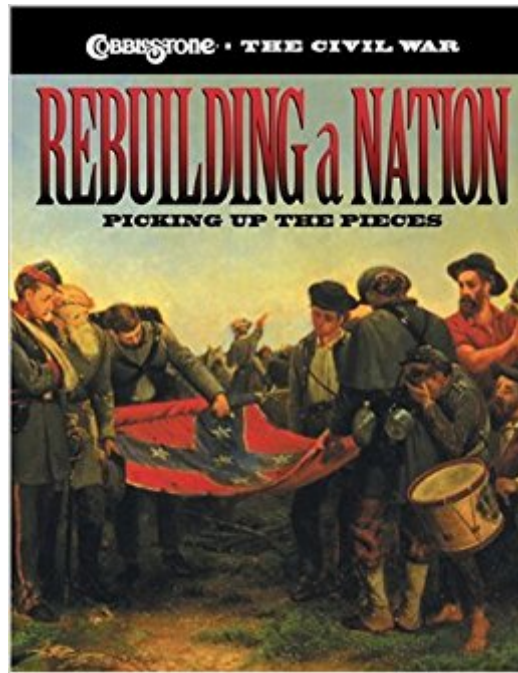




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Rebuilding A Nation: Picking Up The Pieces (Cobblestone The Civil War)
