

It stands alongside works like *The Adventures of Huckleberry Finn*, *Where The Red Fern Grows*, and *Shiloh* as a beloved and enduring classic of literature. Originally published in 1956 to instant acclaim, *Old Yeller* later inspired a hit film from Walt Disney. Just as *Old Yeller* inevitably makes his way into the Coates familyâ™s hearts, this book will find its own special place in readersâ™ hearts.

But can Travis do the same for Old Yeller?

This is a classic from my childhood. I had to buy it for my son's reading assignment in school, but I could not help picking it up and reading it while he was asleep. Classic story which will play well with boys, at least from my perspective, but I suspect anyone who has fond memories of life on a farm with a dog as a child will like the book, too.The violence in the book is the normal violence one would expect from encountering wild animals (hogs). I never found it disturbing and neither did my son.
