I don't usually pay for tabs (this is the internet age!) *or* write reviews, but I was having a hard time finding tabs for sawmill songs I wanted to learn and came across this little ebook during my googling-- it was 100% worth shelling out a buck. Both the song selection and the tabs themselves are great, and I agree with the other reviewer that they're easy enough for a beginner to learn and constructed in such a way as to facilitate elaboration if you're a more advanced player. I will note that the Wayfaring Stranger arrangement was quite different from versions I've heard before (maybe I'm just new to old time music), but once I figured out what was going on with it I became a big fan.

These books are handy, format great on the ipad and what I like best is the tabs are a nice step up from really simple tabs and offer the novice player a step up. I like having the tabs in one location and also like the way the author has put the tabs in one tuning together. The best part is the affordability which makes these tabs available to all. Thanks. They have helped me get a little more complicated with my playing. I listen to the songs most of which I have found on the Internet and after I can hum or sing I sit down and try to play the song.
