

Will Shortz has been the crossword puzzle editor of The New York Times since 1993. Mr. Shortz founded both the American Crossword Puzzle Tournament, where he serves as director, and the World Puzzle Championship, where he is the captain of the U.S. team. He is the current Puzzlemaster for "Weekend Edition Sunday" on National Public Radio.

These quickie-tricky puzzles + warm tea + the glow of a salt lamp are one of my prescriptions to combat insomnia. The clues are smart, twisted and satisfying enough to blow off the steam of the

day. You can also get some feedback humor by telling people that you go to bed with Will Shortz or that your evenings include a cunning linguist. (If you understand either of those lame jokes, you should buy this book.)

This is a great collection of Monday crosswords. If you like to do the NYT crosswords and are like me (just not amazing enough to do the Sunday Puzzles) These Monday puzzles are super fun. You can solve many of them without looking anything up which is how I like to do my crosswords and yet they are often tricky enough to make you do some thinking. The size of the book is perfect for me all the boxes are nice and large and there is plenty of space. Definitely not a travel book though. If you are not a master of crosswords this book also has a lot of puzzles that are easy enough that you can learn some of the tricks puzzlers put into their work. Hopefully by the end you will be ready for Tuesdays.

This is a great quality crossword puzzle book. I bought it for my mother for Christmas and she has been enjoying it immensely - and wants to order the "More Monday Crossword Puzzle" book so she can get more of the same types of puzzles. She loves the lower level of difficulty (without being TOO easy), the larger size of the book and the easy-to-write-on pages. I am so glad I bought this book for her. We will be ordering the "More" book soon as well. This puzzle book is also a great value because there are a lot of puzzles in the book, making the price more than fair.

What can be wrong with a book of 200 crossword puzzles? The New York Times is a leader in puzzles, and this book contains 200 of their easier puzzles. This book is perfect for a lazy Sunday afternoon or a day at the beach. I look forward to bringing this with me on my next vacation.

Now that I am retired, I have plenty of time in the morning to do crosswords and enjoy my coffee. I don't get the newspaper everyday, so it's nice to have this book on hand. I have had this book for about 3 weeks and I've done more than 3/4th of the puzzles in the book. They're very addictive.

This puzzle book is great for times when you need a little relaxation and don't want to tax your mind too much. They offer a reasonable amount of effort but are not too easy. They do not bore you. Recommended for anyone who loves puzzles.
