

Sid Jacobson and Ernie Colon first came together to create the New York Times-bestselling *The 9/11 Report: A Graphic Adaptation* (Hill & Wang/FSG, 2006). Since then, the pair have collaborated on graphic books about Che Guevara, the war on terror, and Anne Frank. Jacobson was formerly the managing editor-and-editor in chief for Harvey Comics and an executive editor at Marvel Comics. Artist Colon has worked at Harvey, Marvel, and DC Comics.

What an incredibly timely body of work! The narrative is powerful, effective and accessible. I have

no doubt that it will prove to be a crucial resource in the days ahead. I highly recommend you purchase the physical book to fully experience the graphics.

Very hard to imagine that a graphic report could give such a concise, accurate account of one of the constitutional tragedies in U.S. History, one that was never repaired and that has nearly been forgotten in the light of lesser constitutional disasters.

This is especially valuable, now that Trump is trying to bury the official report.

This ebook is not formatted well for many devices. The text size is tiny and not adjustable. Trying to read this on a phone or computer is pretty much impossible. (My phone's screen is 5.7 inches). On the kindle reader for my computer I had the same problem. Probably looks fine on a tablet but text size and zoom features are not available on this ebook.
