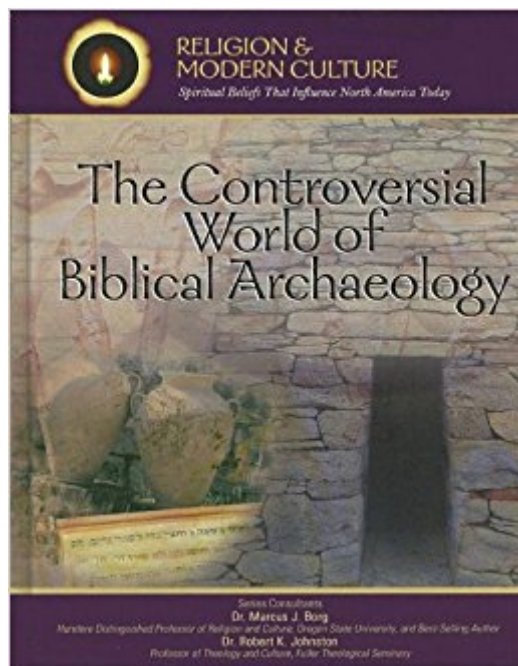

There are those who believe every word, every event, in the Bible is absolutely true. And, of course, there are those somewhere between these viewpoints. Note that I didn't write, "between these two extremes." I don't believe, for example, that it is fair or proper to call the making of the world and everything in it in seven days versus the modern theory of planetary formation, geological processes, and evolution two extreme viewpoints. The answer is not always in the middle. The definitive proof of the existence of people like Moses, Abraham, and Jesus is sketchy at best, and faith is not proof. However, it is clear that people have lived in the Middle East for thousands of years, and that some sites and events mentioned in the Bible have been proven to exist. That is what modern archaeology can do... Separate the wheat from the chaff. This book discusses that discovery as a process. I like that. The authors and consultants writing this book, *The Controversial World of Biblical Archaeology*, encourage you to think and to question. I like that as well. You'll probably find this book in libraries at middle and high schools, as well as at public libraries.
