I only had one problem. Nere. She was a rather stubborn adolescent who failed to grasp the seriousness of many situations until it was too late. Because of her flawed thinking and the underwater action setting, I found I could not really relate to her. I also did not like the little romance theme thrown in the book. It felt rushed and a little forced. Overall not a bad book, but not a great one either.

I read this story in one sitting and enjoyed it very much. I, like a few others, found it hard to picture some of the characters, including Nere, since I didn't know their ages. But it didn't stop me from enjoying the book. I also noticed there wasn't a big climax (major fight scene with the bad guy) at the end because there wasn't a single bad guy through the story. They were on an adventure and they finally reached the end. I've never really seen this done (no climax) before but I didn't mind it at all. I think the age range here is quite wide since the story is limited in bad language and romance. I can see kids anywhere from eight and up enjoying this. I would absolutely read a sequel if one comes out. I am going to recommend this book to other writers in my writing group and at local bookstores. Very well done, Polly, especially for a debut!
